

Policy on Personal Use of Telephone, Email and the Internet on OU Premises

This policy applies to all office-based staff.

The University's policy on the use of the telephone, email and the internet for personal reasons within working hours is that it is permitted, but it is limited to reasonable use i.e. such that it does not impinge on an individual's job performance.

The documents which need to be read in conjunction with this policy are detailed below.
