

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Research Focus: TT284 Web technologies





Aims

- Understand whether the **approaches** used in TU100 and TM129 successfully equips students to study TT284.
- Understand how **tutors** deal with the challenge of working with **students who struggle** with programming.
- Further understand challenges of teaching and learning programming at a distance.

Methods


- Interviewing tutors
- Gathering examples and understanding difficulties
- Qualitative approach: gaining a rich picture of challenges from tutor's perspective











Outcomes

- Understanding tutor practice and experience.
- Understand AL staff development perspectives.
- Roles and **benefits** of technology (OU Live).
- Tutor stories and experience: potential to inform future **module designs** and **future research** directions.
