# Application form for Student Assistance Funding for PGR students

## **Background**

The Student Assistance Fund provides support to students who are facing serious financial hardship due to an unforeseen change in circumstances or an unexpected cost that has arisen through no fault of their own which is affecting their ability to continue studying.

Funds are limited. Awards will be made on a first come first served basis and are not guaranteed. We ask that you give careful consideration to your request prior to submitting your application, only asking for support towards costs which will make a critical difference to your ability to continue studying.

# **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for Student Assistance Funding you must meet the following criteria:

You are directly registered as a Postgraduate Research student and actively studying with the Open University.
 Students registered via Affiliated Research Centres are not eligible to apply.

#### Restrictions

#### Before you make an application, please read the Student Assistance Fund restrictions:

- You can apply once per academic year (1st August 31st July), unless you also require funding for medical
  evidence. In this instance we will consider a further application within the same academic year.
- If you're eligible to apply for your costs via another fund such as Study-Related Costs (<a href="https://help.open.ac.uk/funding-for-computers-internet-childcare/study-related-costs-fund-eng-ni-wal">https://help.open.ac.uk/funding-for-computers-internet-childcare/study-related-costs-fund-eng-ni-wal</a>) or the Discretionary Fund (Scotland <a href="https://help.open.ac.uk/discretionary-funds-scot">https://help.open.ac.uk/discretionary-funds-scot</a>) you are not eligible for Student Assistance Funding.
- · You can request up to a maximum total of £500 depending on what you need funding for.
- · Applications for medical evidence are capped at £50.
- Applications to replace or repair your PC or laptop are capped at £250. We will only offer support towards a PC
  or laptop that is required for studying where you have not been provided with one by the university. Applications
  for another PC or laptop in subsequent academic years will be awarded at the University's discretion.
- Requests for tuition fees or disability equipment cannot be considered.
