Only Frelimo and MDM to stand in all 53 municipalities

The ruling party Frelimo and the main opposition MDM will stand for both president (mayor) and municipal assembly in all 53 municipalities. All parties and citizens' lists which presented lists had them approved, but no other party or list is standing in more than 5 municipalities.

Frelimo, MDM, and five other parties and lists had municipal assembly candidates rejected. CNE spokesman João Beirão said irregularities included missing documents, criminal record certificates showing the candidates had committed crimes which made them ineligible, out of date identity cards, and lack of signatures. Parties were given five days to correct these problems, and where they could not be corrected the candidate was rejected and replaced by someone from the supplementary list parties are allowed to submit.

Rejected candidates included one from Frelimo (in Chimoio), six from MDM (one each in Montepuez, Mueda, and Quelimane and three in Gurué), as well as PDD (2), PARENA (4), PAHUMO (4), ASSEMONA(9) and CINFORTÉCNICA(1).

Beirão stressed that all parties had enough supplementary candidates on their submitted lists to replace those rejected, so revised versions of all lists were accepted.

Parties drawing up code of conduct

More than 50 Maputo-based national parties, including Frelimo, Renamo and MDM, have come together to draw an Electoral Code of Conduct. The code sets out principles to be respected by competing parties during the elections and how to resolve possible conflicts.

So far 22 parties have approved the document: FRELIMO, RENAMO, PT, PEC, PIMO, PANAMO, PDD, PACODE, SOL, UNAMO, PARTONAMO, PANAOC, PVM, PSDM, PSM, PADRES, PPLM, UM, PAMOMO, PADELIMO, MJRD and PPD.

2050 mobilisers to promote voting

About 2050 civic education agents will work during the next 45 days to mobilise people to vote in the 20 November municipal elections. Cláudio Langa, Director of Civil Education and Training at STAE (Secretariado Técnico de Administração Eleitoral), said the civic education brigades would work in communities, schools, churches and other places where people meet to explain the voting procedure and encourage people to vote. There will also be cultural activities, inclduing theatre and music.
