

#### Minimum wages and exchange rates

Minimum wages are set annually and usually run from 1 April; the most recent minimum wages were announced on 27 April 2011. There are now 13 different minimum wages, ranging from \$54 per month for farm workers to \$105 for electricity and gas workers, and then a separate and much higher \$173 in the financial sector. Civil service minimum wages have been effectively frozen at \$77. Minimum wages have been rising steadily since 1996, when there was a single \$24 per month minimum. A separate agricultural minimum was introduced in 2000, in 2008 there was a shift to the 11 different minimum wages, and this was increased to 13 this year.

Until 2000, there was a single minimum wage 2000-2007 there were agricultural and non-agricultural minimum wages From 2008 there have been 11 minimum wages, extended to 13 in 2011.


