Year 1, PGCE1: Nov – Feb ½ Term
Practice Learning: 25 days
(2 to 3 days per week)

Consolidation:
Year 1, PGCE2: Apr – July
Practice Learning: 35 days
(2 to 3 days per week)

Autonomy:
Year 2, PGCE3: Oct – May
Practice Learning: 60 days
(2 to 3 days per week + a full-time 30 day block)
