

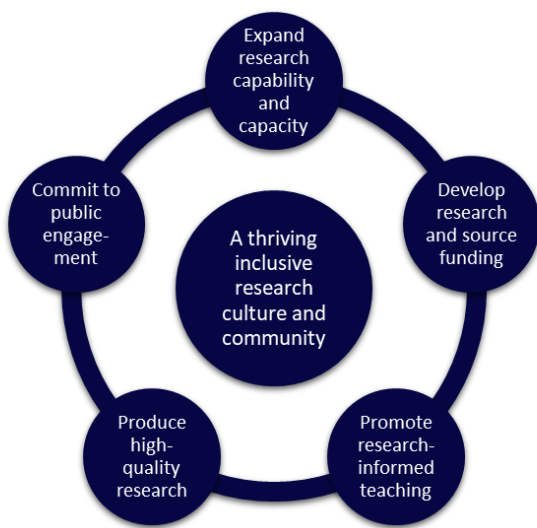

Research Strategy (2024–2027)







The Open University ITE Partnership Programme in Wales will develop an inclusive and inspiring research environment, where creative and collaborative approaches contribute to high-quality research that is impactful and valued by partners and wider society

Research priorities



1. Develop a thriving inclusive research culture and community that includes the wider Open University including the Education, Childhood, Youth and Sport School, student teachers, partner schools and other stakeholders.
2. Expand research capability and capacity with support and mentoring.
3. Develop areas of research and source funding for projects that will support student teachers and practitioners, in Wales, and further afield.
4. Promote and encourage research-informed teaching in universities and schools.
5. Produce high-quality research outputs.
6. Commit to public engagement for our research.

Actions to achieve these priorities will include:

 Collaboration with partners to determine research focus and undertake projects	 Sourcing externally funded research projects
 Developing scholarship and research projects	 Sharing research activity and outputs with the wider community
